

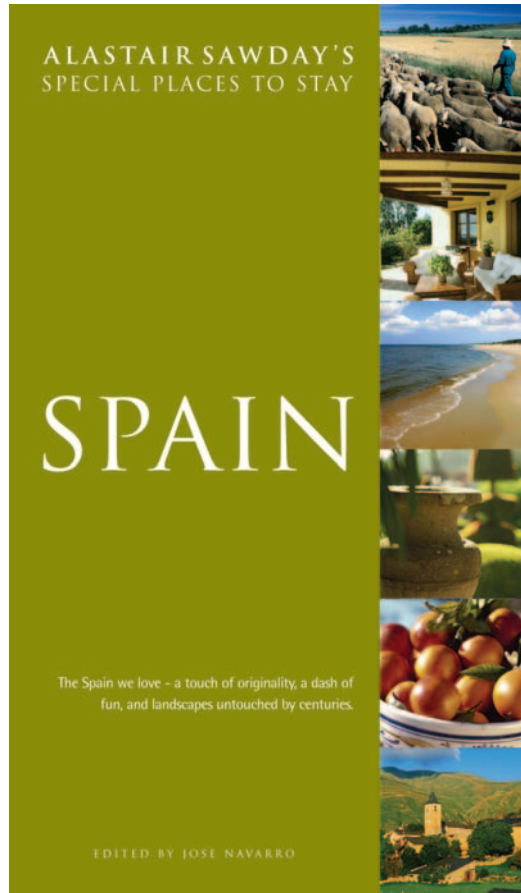

**Finca El Cerrillo**

29755 Canillas de Albaida, Málaga

From the delightfully sleepy square of whitewashed La Axarquía, a narrow road zigzags steeply down into the valley, crosses the river, then loops up to the old finca where olives and raisins were once farmed. When you reach the shady front terrace – with its heart-stopping view south to the Med – you can't fail but slip into that 'I'm on holiday' mood. Everyone loves El Cerrillo, where bedrooms and living spaces are traditionally andalucian and contemporary comforts have been integrated with style. Gordon was a set designer and has an eye for what works, in terms of colour and use of space. Bathrooms are tiled and gleaming, mattresses and linen are first class, and most rooms have the ocean view. Add to this an enchanting garden, a spectacular pool, fabulous breakfasts and dinners, hiking in the sub-tropical valley below, and relaxed and charming hosts. Indeed, it's all so lovely that we recommend you book for several nights. You could also reserve a place on one of their 'Arts at the Finca' events: birdwatching, painting, scriptwriting – just ask.
